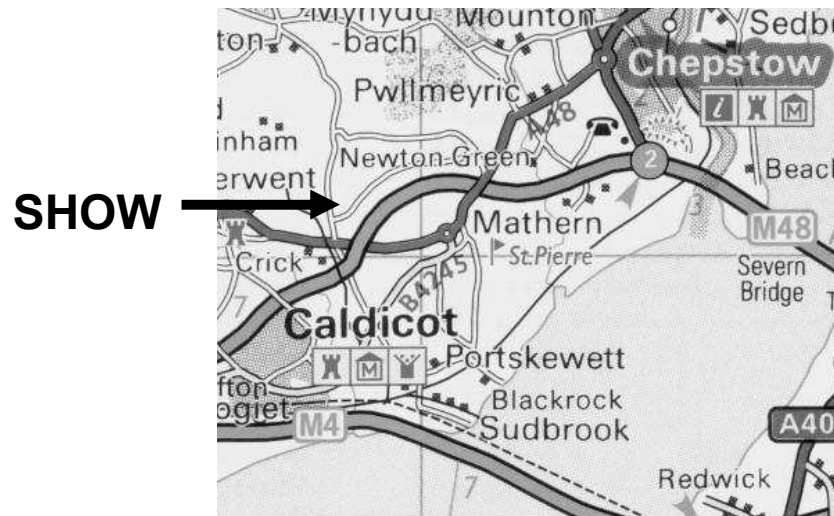


Directions to Chepstow Show



Broadwell Farm, Crick is situated in Hayesgate Lane off the A48 Chepstow to Newport road approximately 4 miles west of Chepstow town centre.

Direction signs will be in place at High Beech roundabout where the A48 from Chepstow meets the link road from M48 and the A466 from Monmouth. Follow signs for Newport along the A48 through Pwllmeyric.

On Show Day diversions will be in place from 7am. This will mean traffic will be unable to turn right from the A48 into Hayesgate Lane at the junction on the approach to the St. Pierre Hotel. Motorists will be directed to continue to the next roundabout and then back along the A48 to turn left into Hayesgate Lane.

Broadwell Farm is situated some 2 miles along Hayesgate Lane, which is narrow and on Show Day will be one way westbound to the Farm. All exhibitors, competitors and traders must approach the site along Hayesgate Lane and enter the showground at the appropriate gate, which will be signed accordingly.

Upon leaving the showground all traffic must turn right into Hayesgate Lane and rejoin the A48 at Crick.

No restrictions or diversions will be in place for any day prior to the Show or after 6pm on the day of the Show.

Rules and Regulations Horse and Pony Section

1. The committee have the right to refuse entries without having to assign any reason.
2. Any entry fee paid shall not be returnable unless the animal is incapacitated by accident, injury or illness. Any claim under this clause must be made in writing to the secretary and must be accompanied by a certificate issued by a veterinary surgeon by the day of the show.
3. Entries will not be accepted unless received on the correct entry form properly completed and signed by the exhibitor, (or his duly authorised agent acting on his behalf), together with the remittance to cover the necessary fees in full, on or before the closing date of entries.
4. No entries will be accepted over the telephone.
5. No unauthorised person shall enter the show or collecting rings.
6. All exhibits are shown at owner's risk.
7. All competitors will carry out steward's instructions.
8. No person shall interfere with the judges or stewards during the course of their duties.
9. The Association, its officers or servants shall not be responsible for any accident, damage or loss, however caused, that may occur to any exhibitor, or his servant, or any animal, article or property, whilst on the showground or whilst entering or leaving.
10. Objections which can only be lodged by competitors in the class concerned must be in writing and delivered to the secretary within 30 minutes of completion of judging of the class involved. A deposit of £30 must accompany the objection, which will be forfeited if the objection is unsuccessful.
11. The decision of the committee appointed to consider objections or protests or any dispute that may arise to be final.
12. Correct and safe dress must be worn at all times. Protective headgear must be worn while mounted in any part of the show ground at all times. It is the duty of the riders, in the interest of their safety to insure that their headgear provides proper protection, is to the appropriate standard, is correctly fitted and remains in place.
13. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to arrive on the showground at least 1 hour before the scheduled time of their class to allow for traffic congestion in the vicinity of the show.
14. The timetable is an approximate guideline only and the show committee reserve the right to alter ring allocation or the timing of classes as may be necessary.
15. No classes will be held waiting for a competitor or horse/pony competing in another class, in the event of classes clashing it is up to the competitor to choose which class they want to compete in.
16. The Association will not be responsible for any loss where an exhibitor has made entries in more than one class and because of a time overrun it is not possible for him/her or the horse/pony to compete in one or more later classes. No claim for refund of fees paid or other loss, direct, indirect or consequential will be accepted or paid.
17. All owners/riders or horse/ponies competing in any event shall be deemed to be subject to the rules and regulations of Chepstow Agricultural Show. There will be no farrier present at the show.
18. A Veterinary Surgeon will be in attendance all day.
19. Classes are open to all whether member or non member of any affiliation.
20. Entries close on the 30th July. Late entries in Show Jumping ring only.
21. All Trophies are Perpetual and must be returned 2 weeks prior to show.
22. In-Hand Stallions and Colts: Stallions/Colts may NOT be LED by any Juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
23. Ridden Stallions: Any Pony Stallion not exceeding 138cms(13.2h) or Small Breed Mountain & Moorland Stallions may NOT be ridden by juniors who have NOT attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year at any show affiliated to South West Pony Association Stallions exceeding 138cms(13.2h) or Large Breed Mountain & Moorland Stallions may NOT be ridden by Juniors who have NOT attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year at any show affiliated to South West Pony Association. *(unless otherwise governed by the individual Breed Society).*

4. Return the card together with any registration fees due within 14 days of this show.

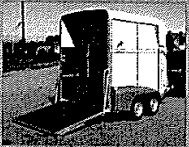
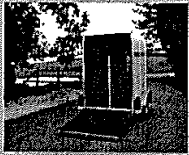

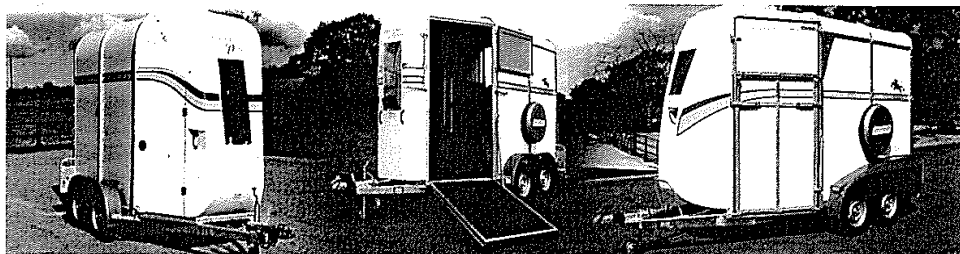

by the judge, otherwise the qualification is invalid.

In all WCC Ridden Classes the judge may ride or request a display.

(to be presented in the ring, parent signature required)
- MR2** WHP Mountain and Moorland Mixed Breeds and Height under 133cms (13h) to jump first riders should not have attained their 12th birthday before 1.1.11.
Over 148cms (14.2) riders must have attained their 14th birthday by 1.1.11.
Snaffle Bridles only.
- MR3** Mixed Height Novice Working Hunter Pony

Child's Pony: 138cms (13.2h) and under; on or off the lead rein,
to be judged on manners and suitability.

- R2** Leading Rein : Ponies not to exceed 122cms (12.2h). Riders 10 years and under. Only riders who have not attained their 7th birthday before 1.1.11 can qualify for SWPA Championships. **The highest places Skewbald and Piebald will quality for the BSPA WCC Championship.** Snaffle bit only. **Ira White Perpetual Trophy.**
- R3** family Horse or Pony : Pony must exceed 138cms (13.2h) but under 148cms (14.2h). Coloured pony may measure up to 153cms (15.1h). **The highest places Skewbald and Piebald will quality for the BSPA WCC Championship.** Snaffle bit only, UNDER 153 cms **SPURS MUST NOT BE WORN.**
To be judged on suitability for two generations.
- R4** First Ridden: Ponies not to exceed 128cms (12.2h) riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1.1.11. Snaffle bit only. **The highest placed Skewbald and Piebald will quality fo the BSPA WCC Championship** (A short show will be required).
- R5** Mountain and Moorland Registered Purebred and Part-bred (may be unregistered) : class may be split into large and small breeds if numbers warrant. (A short show will be required).
- R6** Competition Horse or Pony suitable for BD, BE, BS, Stallions, mare or gelding 4 years and over. (Please refer to rules regarding stallions). No M and M. To include qualifier for **Brightwells BSPA Sports Horse** (A short show will be required).
- R7** Ridden Cob/Native: May be presented as Show Cob (hogged, clean legged, pulled tail). Traditional (full feather, main and tail). **The highest placed Skewbald and Piebald will quality for the WCC.** (A short show will be required).
- R8** Ridden Plaited: Light/middle weight 4 years and over, 153cms and over, mare, gelding and stallion (please see regulations regarding stallions). **The highest placed Skewbald and Piebald will quality for the WCC.** (A short show will be required).
- R9** ridden Arab, American and Foreign Breeds may be judged separately if number warrant: horses must be 4years and over, mare, gelding, stallions (please refer to rules regarding stallions) 153cms and over. **The highest placed Skewbald and Piebald will quality for the WCC.** (A short show will be required).
- R10** Ridden Hunter Type: Horses to be 4 years and over and exceeding 148cms, mare, gelding, stallion (pleas see regulations regarding stallions). **The highest placed Skewbald and Piebald will quality for the WCC.** (A short show will be required).

- R11** Championship First and Second from classes R1-R4
